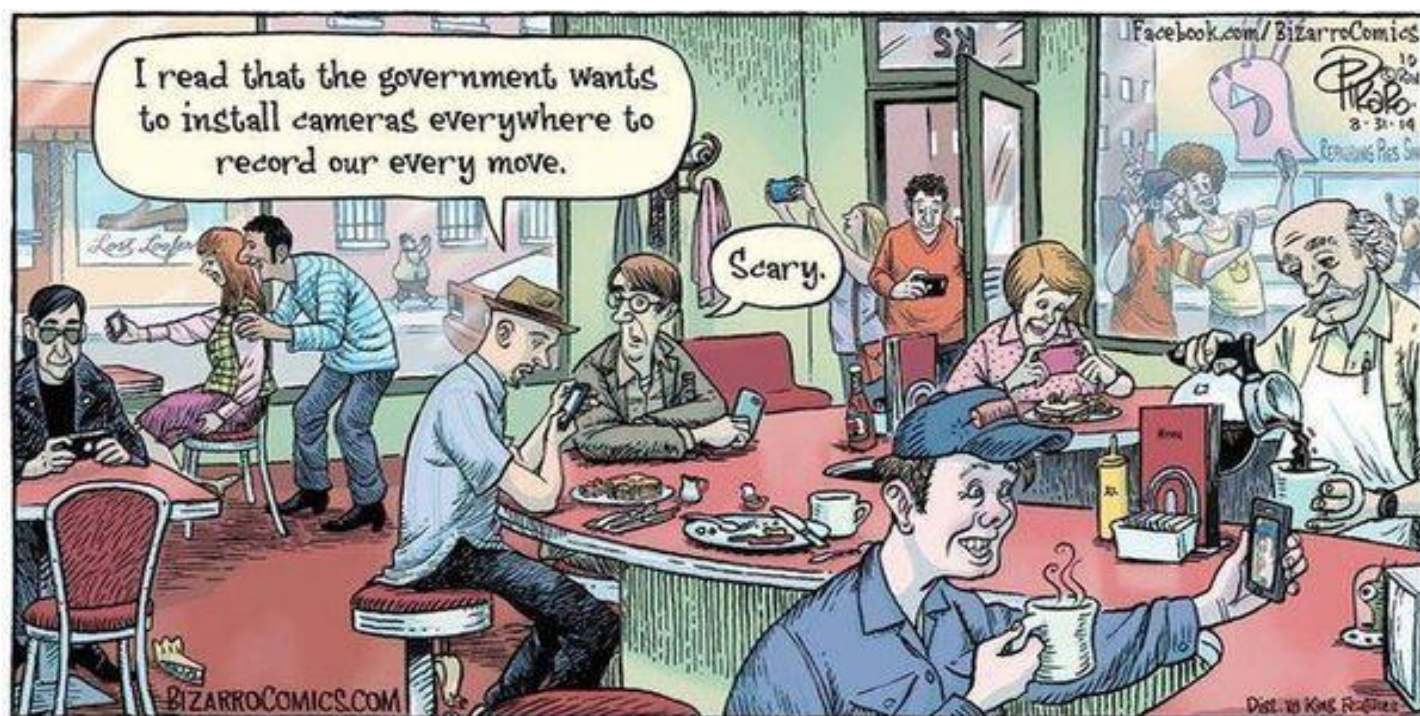
## *Minutes of the September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023, C..S.R.A. Meeting*

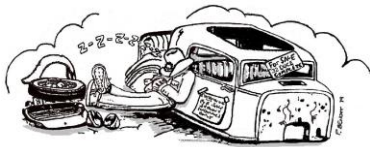

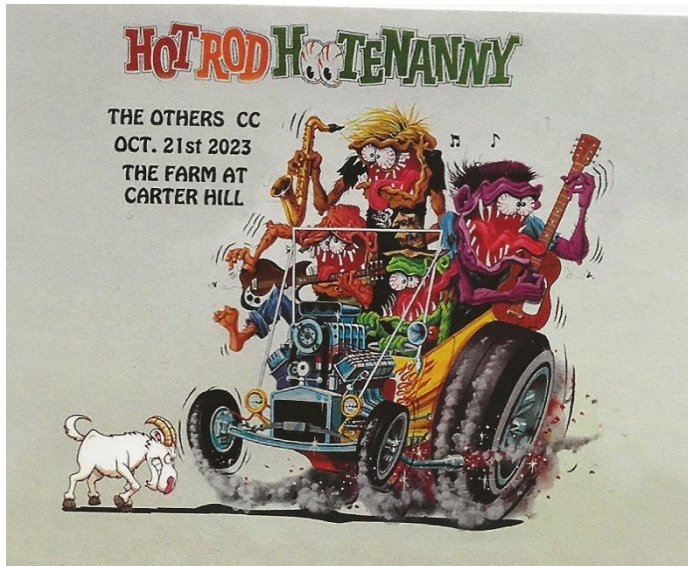
